

Course Enrollments and Student Type






Student Reported Outcomes

- Students are surveyed about their experience after each term with an average 50% return rate.
- Students indicate their program plan of study would be delayed without the availability of NEXus courses and that they take NEXus courses because the course is not available at their home institutions.
- System issues such as transcript procurement are evaluated yearly and modified as needed to achieve the NEXus goal of a seamless student experience.
