What Is NEXus?

NEXus, The Nursing Education Xchange, is a non-profit consortium of institutions from across the country collaborating to increase doctoral-level academic opportunities for students in a cost-effective way. Seventeen member institutions share select courses online.

Why NEXus?

- Fill seats in classes and generate additional income
- Offer a broader range of courses
- Reach a larger group of students with specialized courses

How It Works

Member institutions pay annual dues and students pay a common tuition rate. Tuition is shared among the home and teaching institutions and the NEXus office. Students from member institutions may choose from a catalog of over 300 online graduate course offerings. PhD, DNP and select Masters-level students take advantage of their existing financial aid packages and earn credits toward their own university's program.
