

# **NURS 791: Scholarly Writing**

(This summer semester only course is being offered through NEXus)

# **Course Description:**

This 3 credit foundational course is designed to strengthen the ability of health sciences scholars to engage in effective writing through an emphasis on logical thinking as a critical element in the development and dissemination of knowledge. Learning experiences using on-line technologies will facilitate scholarly learning.

## **Course Objectives:**

Upon completion of this course, the student will be able to:

- 1. Integrate logical thinking into the evaluation of the state of the science within a focused area of interest.
- 2. Apply a systematic process for knowledge dissemination
- 3. Incorporate scholarly writing skills to develop a manuscript for dissemination.
