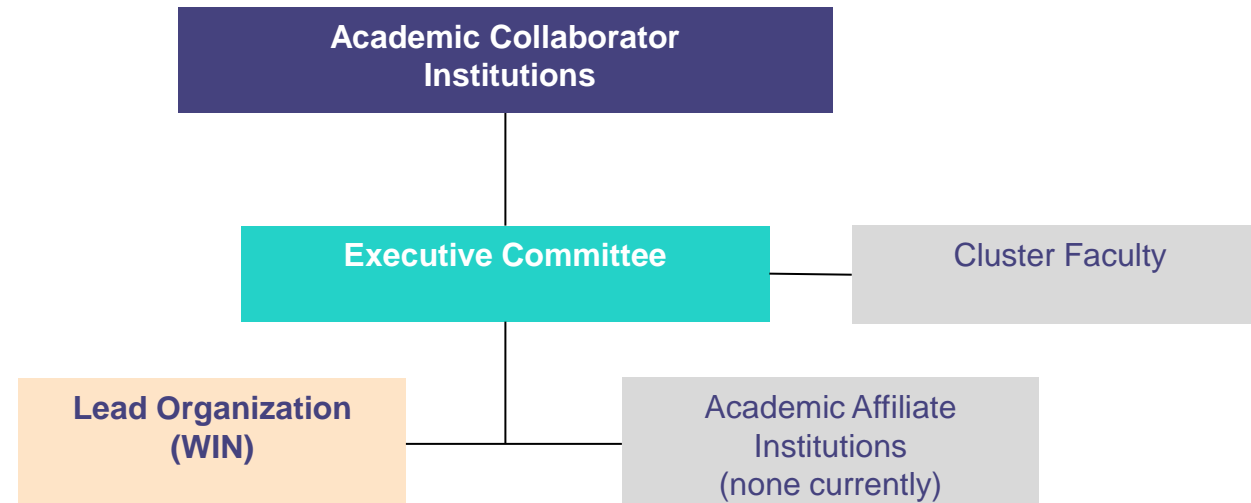

# How NEXus works

## MEMBER INSTITUTIONS:

- ▶ Pay annual dues to participate
- ▶ Facilitate paperwork
- ▶ Collect tuition and share between the Home and Teaching institutions, and NEXus Office.

## STUDENTS:

- ▶ From member institutions choose from >250 online graduate courses <https://winnexus.org/>
- ▶ Use their institutions' process to request to enroll in selected course
- ▶ Earn credits toward their own university's program
- ▶ May take advantage of their existing financial aid
- ▶ Pay a common tuition rate

# NEXus Language

- ▶ TEACH = University offering the course
- ▶ HOME = Institution sending the student
- ▶ Campus Staff Coordinator (CSC) = Administrative Coordinator on Campus for NEXus

# How Students Enroll

1. Student selects Course with Advisor Approval and submits Registration form to Home Coordinator
2. Home Coordinator requests the seat electronically from Teaching Institution Coordinator and institution grants seats.
3. Student submits all other paperwork to Teach including financial aid if applicable. Teach coordinates Admission and Enrollment.
4. Student follows Teach and Home Transcript process.

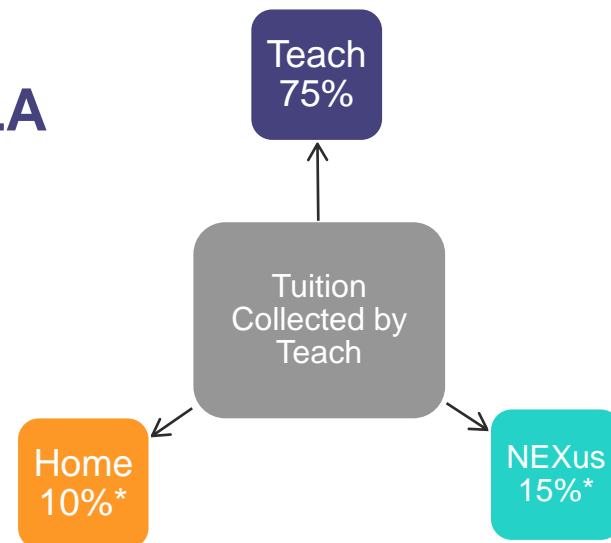

# How the Financials Work

- ▶ Member institutions pay annual dues \$5,000 or \$6,000 depending on level/programs
- ▶ Students pay a common tuition rate \$865/credit
- ▶ Tuition collected by Teaching institution and split three ways

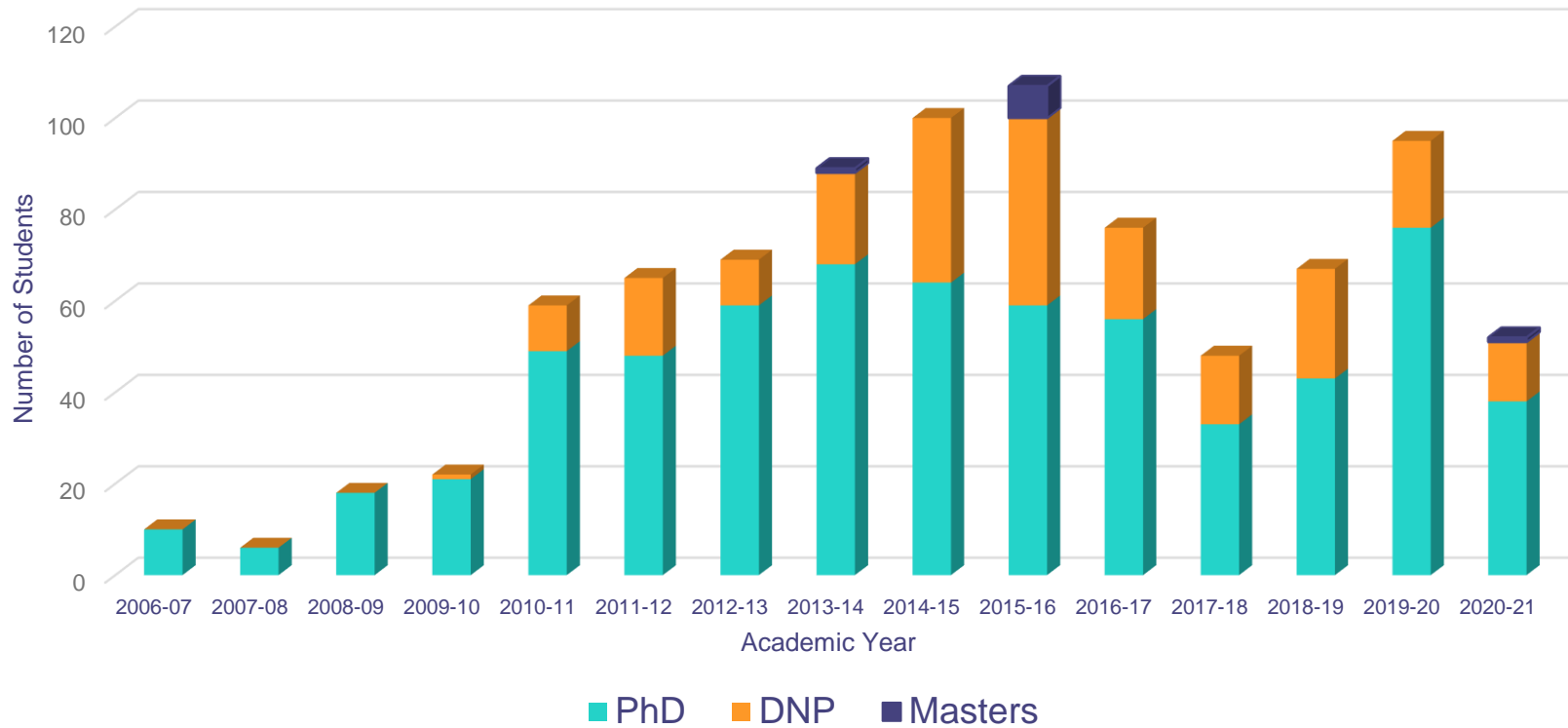

## NEXus Enrollments by Type of Student

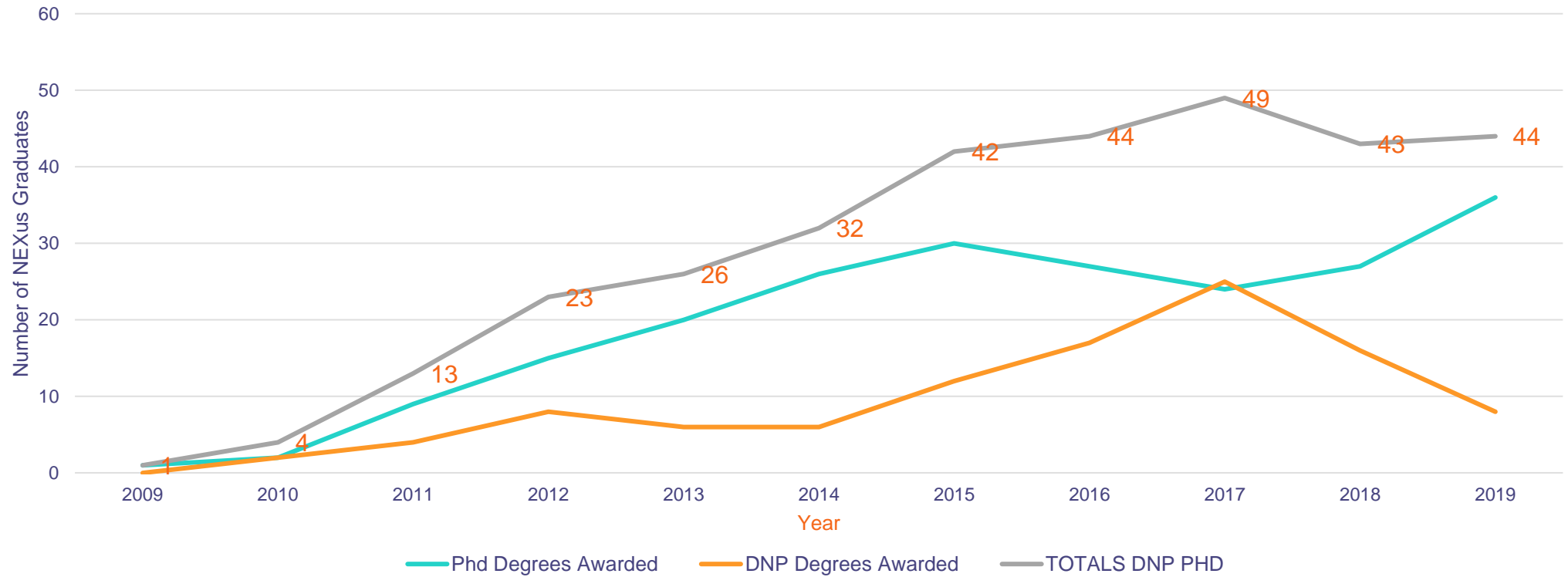

# Best Practices: Organization evaluation practices

- ▶ **Formative and summative approaches** used to
  - ▶ Evaluate the effectiveness of the courses,
  - ▶ Evaluate the exchange itself, and
  - ▶ Assess student/faculty satisfaction.
- ▶ **Course evaluations** are:
  - ▶ Important indicators of effectiveness;
  - ▶ Are administered to participating students/faculty and reviewed periodically



# Evaluation of Course Offerings

- ▶ Each term students and faculty are sent NEXus surveys to complete.
- ▶ Evaluations are overseen by a NEXus Evaluation Committee that includes at least one Executive Committee Member, a Campus Staff Coordinator and the NEXus Project Director.
- ▶ Results are summarized and shared with members
- ▶ Individual institutions receive feedback if specified in an evaluation

# Student Course Evaluations

- ▶ Thirty-eight questions include areas of:

Demographics

Degree program

Career plans

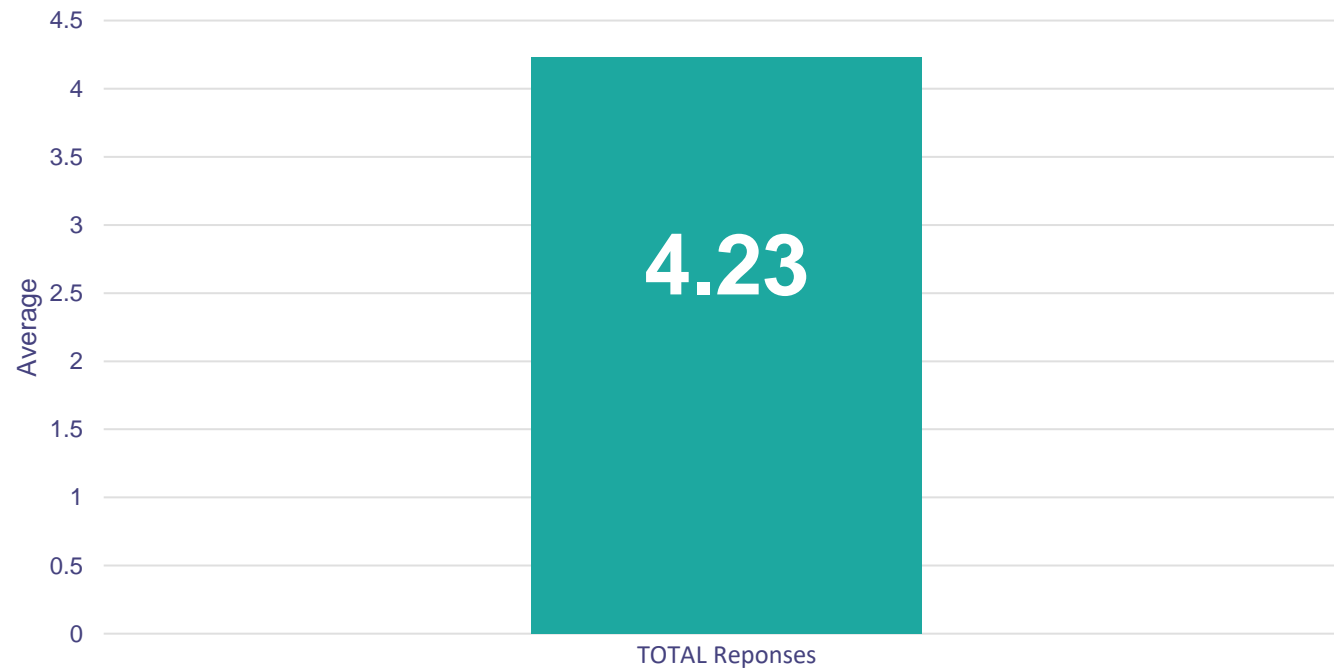

**85% Reported being able to take a course in their degree plan**

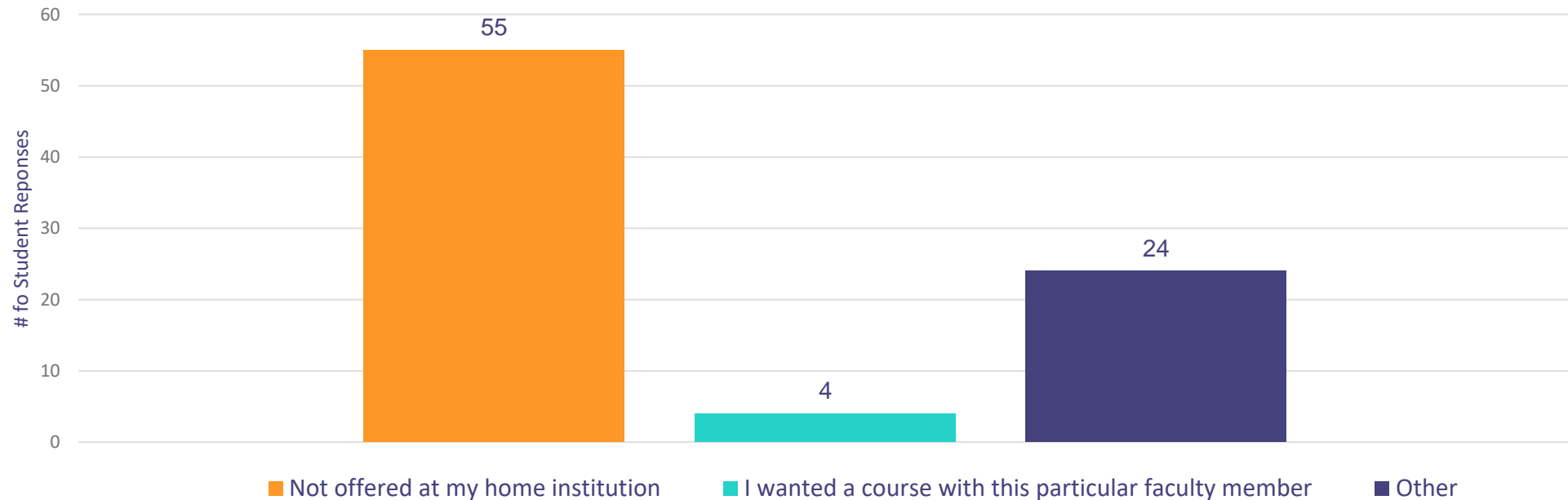


"5" indicates the courses were exceptional in meeting student's needs, and "1" indicates the courses did not meet student's needs.

QUESTION: *Why did you enroll in this NEXus course?*

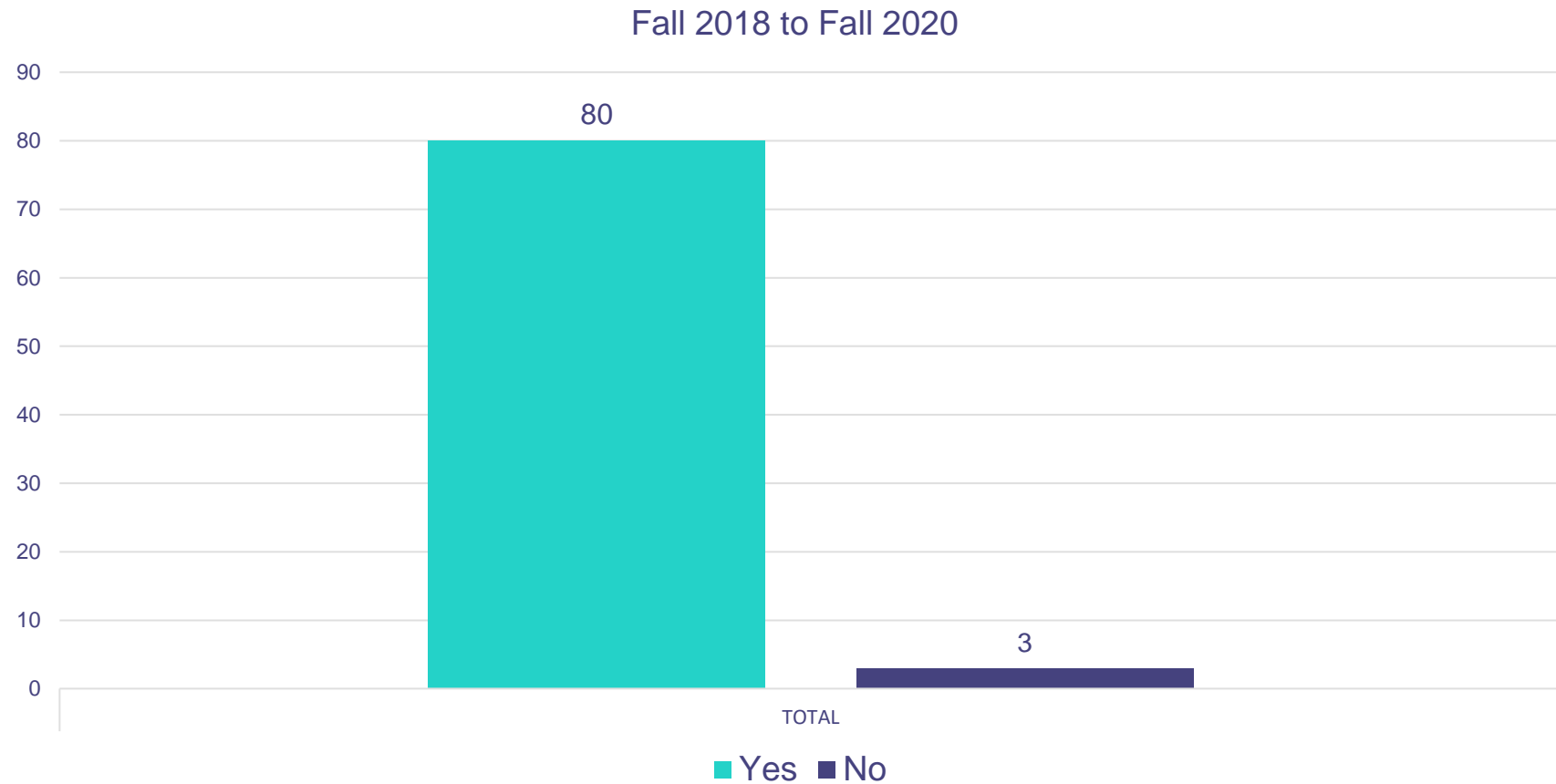
