INTRODUCTION

- With the shortage of nursing faculty, collaborative partnerships among university schools of nursing are necessary to maximize opportunities for doctoral education in nursing.
- The NEXus universities consortium enhances the quality and diversity of graduate education resulting in improvements in advanced practice and health outcomes.

PURPOSE

NEXus – The Nursing Education Xchange, a formal collaboration among schools of nursing, expands online learning opportunities for doctoral students in nursing through cost-effective resource sharing and diverse learning.

METHODS

- PhD, DNP, and MSN students from 16 Schools of Nursing select from 250 graduate courses in 15 concentration areas annually.
- Evaluation of course effectiveness includes student and faculty evaluations of course quality, NEXus enrollment, and student and faculty satisfaction.

RESULTS

- 85% of students reported taking a course not offered at their institution.
- Students were very satisfied with course quality and meeting learning needs (4.12/5.0 effectiveness).











RESULTS
