

NEXus fulfills individual institutional needs and AACN PhD program goals by:

• 1,150 NEXus course registrations (2006-2022)

• 96% of students reported NEXus facilitated remaining on time in program progression

• 85% reporting home institution did not offer the chosen course.

• Students are very satisfied (4.12/5.0) with course quality and meeting learning needs

• More than 440 NEXus students have earned a PhD or DNP degree
